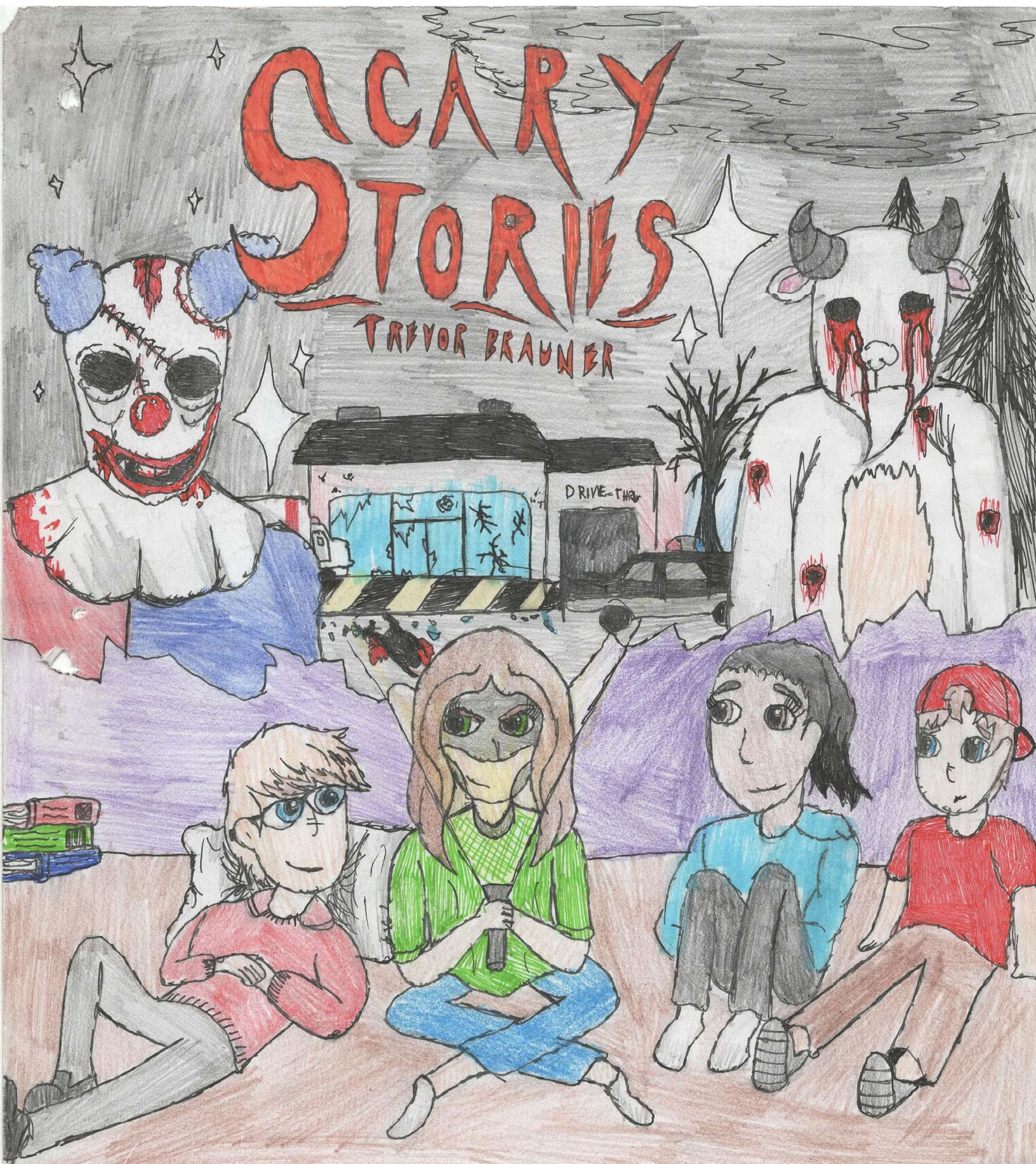

"Nothing." He responded. "I just thought I saw some guy in a cat Mask staring at me."

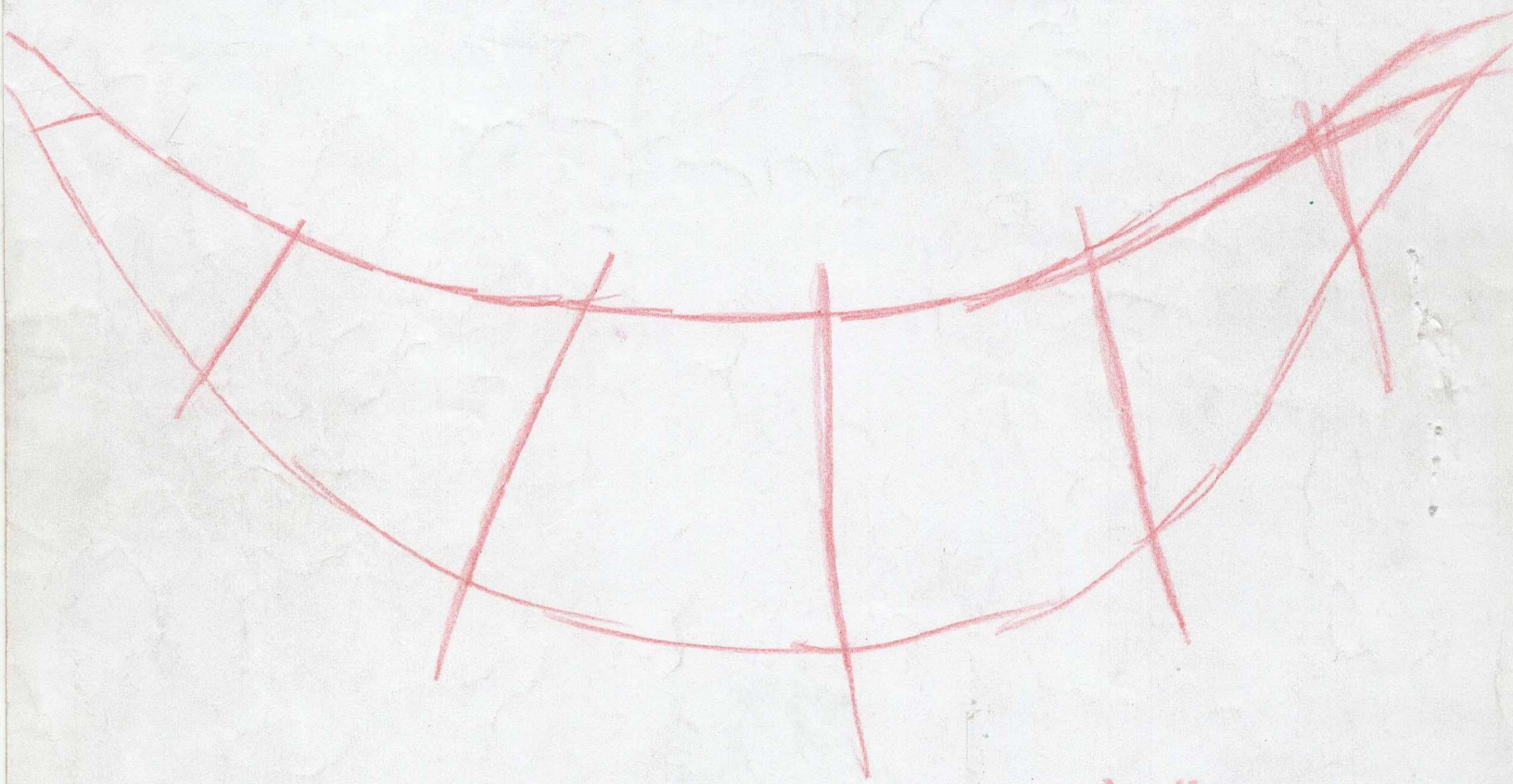
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
